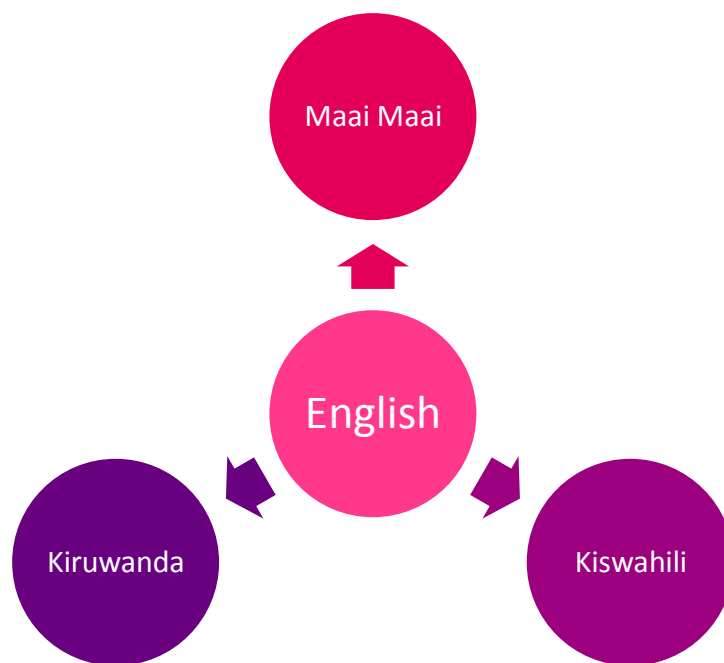


# Interpretation in Multiple Languages

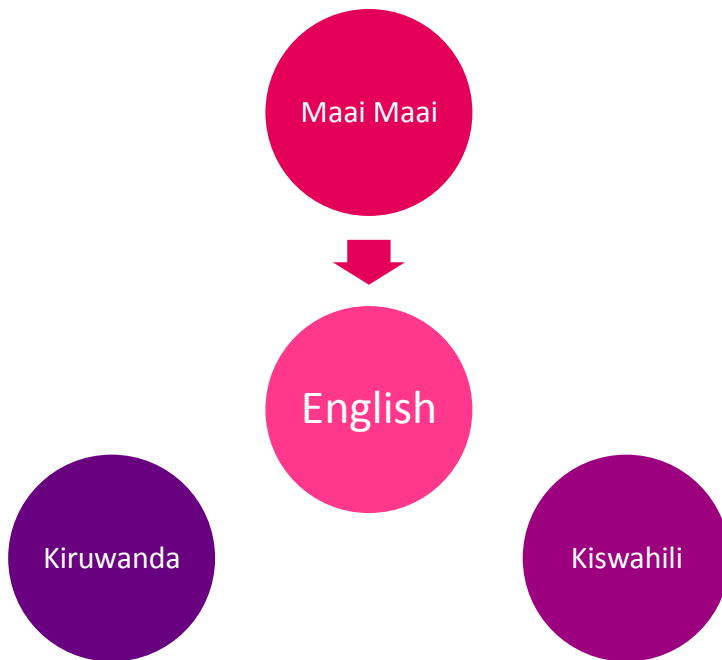
1. Have speakers of each language group sit together. The interpreter should be in front and central to the group.



2. The interpretation path looks like spokes on a wheel. After something is said in the common language (example: English) each interpreter will interpret into their respective languages, at the same time that the other interpreters are also doing so.



3. When someone speaks to the group in another language, that interpreter will first interpret the message into English.



4. The other interpreters will then interpret the message from English into their respective languages (at the same time that other interpreters are doing so).
